Charity Information

Thank you for participating in the Hamilton Law Association New Lawyers' Subcommittee charity initiative *Lawyers Who Care*. The charity that was selected this year is:

Food4Kids Hamilton

There are 1,300 children in Hamilton struggling through each weekend without food.

Food4Kids provides packages of healthy food for kids aged 4-17 years with limited or no access to food each weekend.

The food packages are assembled by volunteers and delivered to schools each week to ensure children have nourishment over the weekend. Staff subtly tuck a food package into each participating student's backpack. This distribution method helps shield the child from any stigma that might be associated with hunger or receiving food assistance.

Food4Kids is funded through donations or one-time grants. While hunger exists around the world, it is their hope to address hunger in the Hamilton community.

During COVID-19, Food4Kids is accepting monetary donations.

For the duration of the lockdown, every student in the program will receive a bi-weekly grocery card. Once the lockdown is lifted, Food4Kids will resume delivering food bags to students inside their school.
