The Income War Tax Act

The *Act* has evolved from a temporary war measure to supplement revenues to a permanent institution distributing the tax burden among all Canadians – or as Finance Minister Sir Thomas White put it in 1917, by taxing “the net profit or gain arising from any business in which a person, as defined in the Act, is engaged...so that everybody in Canada shall be subject to the tax...”
