A Special Form T-1<sup>a</sup> has been provided for the use of farmers, but in the case of a taxpayer carrying on a farming business in addition to his regular occupation he should use Schedule 10, page 3, for the Gross Income therefrom and Schedule 20, page 3, for the Expenses in connection therewith.

PENALTIES: The Income War Tax Act, 1917, provides that every person required to make an Income Tax return who fails to do so is liable to a penalty of \$100.00 for every day during which the default continues. Also that any person making a false statement in any return is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000.00 or to six months' imprisonment or to both fine and imprisonment.

Dear Sir,—

I do not appear to have received from you an Income Tax return on Form T. 1 as required by the Income War Tax Act, 1917. I enclose herewith three blank forms and have to ask you to be good enough to complete the same and forward two copies thereof to this office without delay, showing your gross income and deductions therefrom for the calendar year 1918.

I call your attention to the fact that Section 7 of the Act requires all persons liable to the tax to make Income Tax returns, without notice from the Department, within the time limited. In addition to those persons all others who are requested to make returns in accordance with Section 8 of the Act are bound to do so.

This return now asked for should therefore be completed and returned to me in duplicate whether or not you deem yourself liable to taxation.

I trust you will co-operate with the Department by giving this matter your prompt attention.

**PENALTY:**—The Income War Tax Act, 1917, as amended, provides that every person required to make a return under Sub. Sec. 1 of Sec. 7 of the Act who fails to make a return within the time limited therefor, shall be subject to a penalty of Twenty-Five per centum of the amount of the tax payable.

Any person, whether taxable or otherwise, who fails to make a return or provide information duly required according to the provisions of Sec. 8 of the Act, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$100 for each day during which the default continues. Also that any person making a false statement in any return or in any information required by the Minister, shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, or to six months' imprisonment or to both fine and imprisonment.
